DRIVERS LICENSES AND CAR REGISTRATION

www.dmv.ca.gov

A California driver's license is required within 10 days of establishing residency in the state. Transferring a license requires proof of a valid out-of-state driver's license, social security card, birth certificate and \$26.00. You need only to pass a vision and written test. Registration of your vehicle must be done within 20 days of establishing residency. Verification of certified smog check is required by the DMV. The cost of registration varies depending on the value of your automobile.
