

## California Western Travel Policy

All members of the California Western School of Law community who travel either domestically or internationally must comply with current CDC recommendations to re-enter the campus upon their return to San Diego. CDC recommendations may be different based on your vaccination status.

Pursuant to the CDC recommendations as of August 2021, unvaccinated individuals should be tested for COVID-19 before and after travel, and should self-quarantine for 7 days (with a negative test) and 10 days regardless of symptoms, as well as follow all other recommendations.
