



## Superior Court commissioner appointed to judge

SAN DIEGO — A San Diego court commissioner has been appointed to serve as a Superior Court judge, Gov. Jerry Brown's office announced Tuesday.

Keri G. Katz, 52, has been a court commissioner since 2007. Before then, she was chief operating officer for the San Diego city water department, and spent nearly 20 years in the San Diego City Attorney's Office, where she served a stint as assistant city attorney and once led that office's civil division.

She has a bachelor of arts degree from the University of California, Los Angeles, and a law degree from California Western School of Law.

Katz, a Democrat, will fill the vacancy on the bench created by the retirement of Judge Alvin Green
