

# Free legal clinic opens in Hillcrest

HILLCREST — A legal clinic offering free and low-cost services from California Western School of Law has opened in Hillcrest.

The clinic will be open from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. on the second Tuesday of each month at the LGBT Center, 3909 Centre St.

It is the school's fourth Access to Law Initiative clinic to open since 2012, with two others in downtown San Diego and one in San Marcos, according to Cal Western spokesman Chris Saunders.

Volunteer lawyers are available for free 30-minute consultations to evaluate clients' legal problems, Saunders said. He said the services are paid for through the office of City Councilman Todd Gloria.

Gloria said in a statement that he supports the law school's program "to remove barriers to trustworthy legal advice."

The clinics not only help low-income residents with legal problems, but provides training to the law school students program director Bob Seibel said in a statement.
