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New Media Rights has been awarded a Citywide Small Business Enhancement Program grant from the City of San Diego Office of Small Business for the fourth year in a row. New Media Rights is a clinical program at California Western School of Law that provides legal services, advocacy, and education to Internet users.

“This unique type of technical assistance is of great value to entrepreneurs and small businesses served through this program,” members of the grant review committee wrote. “This specialized and tailored assistance also supports small businesses within the arts and creative communities, which is greatly needed.” In

addition to helping individual Internet users and tech startups, New Media Rights focuses on assisting organizations that provide better access to public information, greater business, and government accountability, or unique new perspectives to the cultural landscape. New Media Rights also takes part in regulatory proceedings at the FCC and U.S. Copyright Office. New Media Rights received a perfect score on the grant application, and will receive \$24,197 in funding.
