

Student Reporting Requirements

Students have an obligation to notify the Vice Dean for Academic Affairs or the Vice President of Student Life immediately if any of the following events occur: (1) you are apprehended, cited, arrested, taken into custody for, charged with, indicted, or tried for, or plead guilty or no contest (nolo contendere) to, the commission of any felony or misdemeanor or the violation of any law, except for minor traffic violations unrelated to the use of intoxicants; (2) you are found guilty of an honor code violation at any institution of higher learning; (3) become a plaintiff or defendant in a civil lawsuit; (4) receive an order of expungement or similar order for a criminal conviction; or (5) you are subject to disciplinary action by any educational institution, governmental, or administrative agency (including any branch of the Armed Forces), or employer. Written notification must be submitted to the Vice Dean for Academic Affairs or the Vice President for Student Life. Failure to provide notification to the law school may constitute an Honor Code violation. (Updated May 2016)
