The Tom Homann LGBTQ+ Law Foundation ("Foundation")—the charitable organization to the Tom Homann LGBTQ+ Law Association ("THLA")—awards scholarships to deserving, qualified, and eligible law students. Applicants need not identify as LGBTQ+, and allies are encouraged to apply. The Foundation reserves the right to determine the number of scholarship recipients and the respective amount of each scholarship. The Foundation expects to notify scholarship recipients by late March. Recipients are invited to attend THLA's Annual Awards Dinner on June 26, 2025, where they will be briefly recognized during the program.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for a scholarship award, Applicants must:

- 1. Be a current, paid member of the Tom Homann LGBTQ+ Law Association ("THLA") as of the date the Foundation receives the Application.
 - (Students can become members on <u>THLA's website</u>. The Foundation confirms THLA membership before reviewing any Application. Please contact <u>info@thla.org</u>, or the <u>THLA Co-Presidents</u>, with questions about THLA membership status.)
- 2. Be enrolled at an ABA-accredited or California-accredited law school.
- 3. Demonstrate ties to the San Diego legal community. This includes any law student enrolled at a qualifying law school in San Diego County, any law student who demonstrates significant ties to San Diego, or any law student who intends to work in San Diego after graduation from law school.
- 4. Submit a complete application on or before the deadline listed above.
- 5. Make best efforts to attend a recognition event if selected as a scholarship recipient, which usually takes place during THLA's Annual Awards Dinner.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Foundation awards scholarships based the following criteria:

- 1. Current and past leadership experience or general involvement in LGBTQ+ organizations or the LGBTQ+ community, including efforts to promote diversity in the legal profession, legal organizations, or other communities or organizations.
- 2. Current and past leadership experience, or general involvement with, other organizations (preferably legal in nature).
- 3. Academic achievement in law school.
- 4. Financial need.
- 5. Applicant's personal statement and responses to all prompts in this Application.
